He spoke about Gujarat's industrial ecosystem, which is vibrant, dynamic, and scaled for global impact. He strongly encouraged every delegate to utilise the next three days to visit the Expo, where the strategies discussed in the conference will materialise.

The inaugural session was followed by focused conference sessions, with key discussion themes covering Navigating Global Trade Challenges, Becoming Future-Ready with AI, and Emerging Regulations in the Chemicals and Petrochemicals Sector.
